NIV Matt. 25:40 "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.'

NIV Lk. 21:16 You will be betrayed even by parents, brothers and sisters, relatives and friends, and they will put some of you to death.

NIV Acts 1:16 and said, "Brothers and sisters, the Scripture had to be fulfilled in which the Holy Spirit spoke long ago through David concerning Judas, who served as guide for those who arrested Jesus.

NIV Acts 6:3 Brothers and sisters, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them

NIV Acts 11:29 The disciples, as each one was able, decided to provide help for the brothers and sisters living in Judea.

NIV Acts 12:17 Peter motioned with his hand for them to be quiet and described how the Lord had brought him out of prison. "Tell James and the other brothers and sisters about this," he said, and then he left for another place.

NIV Acts 16:40 After Paul and Silas came out of the prison, they went to Lydia's house, where they met with the brothers and sisters and encouraged them. Then they left.

NIV Acts 18:18 Paul stayed on in Corinth for some time. Then he left the brothers and sisters and sailed for Syria, accompanied by Priscilla and Aquila. Before he sailed, he had his hair cut off at Cenchreae because of a vow he had taken.

NIV Acts 18:27 When Apollos wanted to go to Achaia, the brothers and sisters encouraged him and wrote to the disciples there to welcome him. When he arrived, he was a great help to those who by grace had believed.

NIV Acts 21:7 We continued our voyage from Tyre and landed at Ptolemais, where we greeted the brothers and sisters and stayed with them for a day.

NIV Acts 21:17 When we arrived at Jerusalem, the brothers and sisters received us warmly.

NIV Acts 28:14 There we found some brothers and sisters who invited us to spend a week with them. And so we came to Rome.

NIV Acts 28:15 The brothers and sisters there had heard that we were coming, and they traveled as far as the Forum of Appius and the Three Taverns to meet us. At the sight of these people Paul thanked God and was encouraged.

NIV Rom. 1:13 I do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, that I planned many times to come to you (but have been prevented from doing so until now) in order that I might have a harvest among you, just as I have had among the other Gentiles.

NIV Rom. 7:1 Do you not know, brothers and sisters-- for I am speaking to those who know the law-- that the law has authority over someone only as long as that person lives?

NIV Rom. 7:4 So, my brothers and sisters, you also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God.

NIV Rom. 8:12 Therefore, brothers and sisters, we have an obligation-- but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it.

NIV Rom. 8:29 For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

NIV Rom. 10:1 Brothers and sisters, my heart's desire and prayer to God for the Israelites is that they may be saved.

NIV Rom. 11:25 I do not want you to be ignorant of this mystery, brothers and sisters, so that you may not be conceited: Israel has experienced a hardening in part until the full number of the Gentiles has come in,

NIV Rom. 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God-- this is your true and proper worship.

NIV Rom. 15:14 I myself am convinced, my brothers and sisters, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with knowledge and competent to instruct one another.

NIV Rom. 15:30 I urge you, brothers and sisters, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me.

NIV Rom. 16:14 Greet Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermes, Patrobas, Hermas and the other brothers and sisters with them.

NIV Rom. 16:17 I urge you, brothers and sisters, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them.

NIV 1 Cor. 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought.

NIV 1 Cor. 1:11 My brothers and sisters, some from Chloe's household have informed me that there are quarrels among you.

NIV 1 Cor. 1:26 Brothers and sisters, think of what you were when you were called. Not many of you were wise by human standards; not many were influential; not many were of noble birth.

NIV 1 Cor. 2:1 And so it was with me, brothers and sisters. When I came to you, I did not come with eloquence or human wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God.

NIV 1 Cor. 3:1 Brothers and sisters, I could not address you as people who live by the Spirit but as people who are still worldly-- mere infants in Christ.

NIV 1 Cor. 4:6 Now, brothers and sisters, I have applied these things to myself and Apollos for your benefit, so that you may learn from us the meaning of the saying, "Do not go beyond what is written." Then you will not be puffed up in being a follower of one of us over against the other.

NIV 1 Cor. 6:8 Instead, you yourselves cheat and do wrong, and you do this to your brothers and sisters.

NIV 1 Cor. 7:24 Brothers and sisters, each person, as responsible to God, should remain in the situation they were in when God called them.

NIV 1 Cor. 7:29 What I mean, brothers and sisters, is that the time is short. From now on those who have wives should live as if they do not;

NIV 1 Cor. 10:1 For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea.
NIV 1 Cor. 11:33 So then, my brothers and sisters, when you gather to eat, you should all eat together.

NIV 1 Cor. 12:1 Now about the gifts of the Spirit, brothers and sisters, I do not want you to be uninformed.

NIV 1 Cor. 14:6 Now, brothers and sisters, if I come to you and speak in tongues, what good will I be to you, unless I bring you some revelation or knowledge or prophecy or word of instruction?

NIV 1 Cor. 14:20 Brothers and sisters, stop thinking like children. In regard to evil be infants, but in your thinking be adults.

NIV 1 Cor. 14:26 What then shall we say, brothers and sisters? When you come together, each of you has a hymn, or a word of instruction, a revelation, a tongue or an interpretation. Everything must be done so that the church may be built up.

NIV 1 Cor. 14:39 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, be eager to prophesy, and do not forbid speaking in tongues.

NIV 1 Cor. 15:1 Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand.

NIV 1 Cor. 15:6 After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

NIV 1 Cor. 15:50 I declare to you, brothers and sisters, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.

NIV 1 Cor. 15:58 Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

NIV 1 Cor. 16:15 You know that the household of Stephanas were the first converts in Achaia, and they have devoted themselves to the service of the Lord's people. I urge you, brothers and sisters,

NIV 1 Cor. 16:20 All the brothers and sisters here send you greetings. Greet one another with a holy kiss.

NIV 2 Cor. 1:8 We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about the troubles we experienced in the province of Asia. We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired of life itself.

NIV 2 Cor. 8:1 And now, brothers and sisters, we want you to know about the grace that God has given the Macedonian churches.

NIV 2 Cor. 13:11 Finally, brothers and sisters, rejoice! Strive for full restoration, encourage one another, be of one mind, live in peace. And the God of love and peace will be with you.

NIV Gal. 1:2 and all the brothers and sisters with me, To the churches in Galatia:

NIV Gal. 1:11 I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel I preached is not of human origin.

NIV Gal. 3:15 Brothers and sisters, let me take an example from everyday life. Just as no one can set aside or add to a human covenant that has been duly established, so it is in this case.

NIV Gal. 4:12 I plead with you, brothers and sisters, become like me, for I became like you. You did me no wrong.

NIV Gal. 4:28 Now you, brothers and sisters, like Isaac, are children of promise.

NIV Gal. 4:31 Therefore, brothers and sisters, we are not children of the slave woman, but of the free woman.

NIV Gal. 5:11 Brothers and sisters, if I am still preaching circumcision, why am I still being persecuted? In that case the offense of the cross has been abolished.

NIV Gal. 5:13 You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

NIV Gal. 6:1 Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently. But watch yourselves, or you also may be tempted.

NIV Gal. 6:18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers and sisters. Amen.

NIV Eph. 6:23 Peace to the brothers and sisters, and love with faith from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

NIV Phil. 1:12 Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has actually served to advance the gospel.

NIV Phil. 1:14 And because of my chains, most of the brothers and sisters have become confident in the Lord and dare all the more to proclaim the gospel without fear.

NIV Phil. 3:1 Further, my brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord! It is no trouble for me to write the same things to you again, and it is a safeguard for you.

NIV Phil. 3:13 Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead,

NIV Phil. 3:17 Join together in following my example, brothers and sisters, and just as you have us as a model, keep your eyes on those who live as we do.

NIV Phil. 4:1 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends!

NIV Phil. 4:8 Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable-- if anything is excellent or praiseworthy-- think about such things.

NIV Phil. 4:21 Greet all God's people in Christ Jesus. The brothers and sisters who are with me send greetings.

NIV Col. 1:2 To God's holy people in Colossae, the faithful brothers and sisters in Christ: Grace and peace to you from God our Father.

NIV Col. 4:15 Give my greetings to the brothers and sisters at Laodicea, and to Nympha and the church in her house.

NIV 1 Thess. 1:4 For we know, brothers and sisters loved by God, that he has chosen you,

NIV 1 Thess. 2:1 You know, brothers and sisters, that our visit to you was not without results.

NIV 1 Thess. 2:9 Surely you remember, brothers and sisters, our toil and hardship; we worked night and day in order not to be a burden to anyone while we preached the gospel of God to you.

NIV 1 Thess. 2:14 For you, brothers and sisters, became imitators of God's churches in Judea, which are in Christ Jesus: You suffered from your own people the same things those churches suffered from the Jews

NIV 1 Thess. 2:17 But, brothers and sisters, when we were orphaned by being separated from you for a short time (in person, not in thought), out of our intense longing we made every effort to see you.

NIV 1 Thess. 3:7 Therefore, brothers and sisters, in all our distress and persecution we were encouraged about you because of your faith.

NIV 1 Thess. 4:1 As for other matters, brothers and sisters, we instructed you how to live in order to please God, as in fact you are living. Now we ask you and urge you in the Lord Jesus to do this more and more.

NIV 1 Thess. 4:10 And in fact, you do love all of God's family throughout Macedonia. Yet we urge you, brothers and sisters, to do so more and more,

NIV 1 Thess. 4:13 Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope.

NIV 1 Thess. 5:1 Now, brothers and sisters, about times and dates we do not need to write to you,

NIV 1 Thess. 5:4 But you, brothers and sisters, are not in darkness so that this day should surprise you like a thief.

NIV 1 Thess. 5:12 Now we ask you, brothers and sisters, to acknowledge those who work hard among you, who care for you in the Lord and who admonish you.

NIV 1 Thess. 5:14 And we urge you, brothers and sisters, warn those who are idle and disruptive, encourage the disheartened, help the weak, be patient with everyone.

NIV 1 Thess. 5:25 Brothers and sisters, pray for us.

NIV 1 Thess. 5:27 I charge you before the Lord to have this letter read to all the brothers and sisters.

NIV 2 Thess. 1:3 We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing.

NIV 2 Thess. 2:1 Concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered to him, we ask you, brothers and sisters,

NIV 2 Thess. 2:13 But we ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters loved by the Lord, because God chose you as firstfruits to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth.

NIV 2 Thess. 2:15 So then, brothers and sisters, stand firm and hold fast to the teachings we passed on to you, whether by word of mouth or by letter.

NIV 2 Thess. 3:1 As for other matters, brothers and sisters, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you.

NIV 2 Thess. 3:6 In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, we command you, brothers and sisters, to keep away from every believer who is idle and disruptive and does not live according to the teaching you received from us.

NIV 2 Thess. 3:13 And as for you, brothers and sisters, never tire of doing what is good.

NIV 1 Tim. 4:6 If you point these things out to the brothers and sisters, you will be a good minister of Christ Jesus, nourished on the truths of the faith and of the good teaching that you have followed.

NIV 2 Tim. 4:21 Do your best to get here before winter. Eubulus greets you, and so do Pudens, Linus, Claudia and all the brothers and sisters.

NIV Heb. 2:11 Both the one who makes people holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. So Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers and sisters.

NIV Heb. 2:12 He says, "I will declare your name to my brothers and sisters; in the assembly I will sing your praises."

NIV Heb. 3:1 Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, whom we acknowledge as our apostle and high priest.

NIV Heb. 3:12 See to it, brothers and sisters, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God.

NIV Heb. 10:19 Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus,

NIV Heb. 13:1 Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters.

NIV Heb. 13:22 Brothers and sisters, I urge you to bear with my word of exhortation, for in fact I have written to you quite briefly.

NIV Jas. 1:2 Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds,

NIV Jas. 1:16 Don't be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters.

NIV Jas. 1:19 My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry,

NIV Jas. 2:1 My brothers and sisters, believers in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ must not show favoritism.

NIV Jas. 2:5 Listen, my dear brothers and sisters: Has not God chosen those who are poor in the eyes of the world to be rich in faith and to inherit the kingdom he promised those who love him?

NIV Jas. 2:14 What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them?

NIV Jas. 3:10 Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers and sisters, this should not be.

NIV Jas. 3:12 My brothers and sisters, can a fig tree bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs? Neither can a salt spring produce fresh water.

NIV Jas. 4:11 Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it.

NIV Jas. 5:7 Be patient, then, brothers and sisters, until the Lord's coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop, patiently waiting for the autumn and spring rains.

NIV Jas. 5:9 Don't grumble against one another, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door!

NIV Jas. 5:10 Brothers and sisters, as an example of patience in the face of suffering, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.

NIV Jas. 5:12 Above all, my brothers and sisters, do not swear-- not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. All you need to say is a simple "Yes" or "No." Otherwise you will be condemned.

NIV Jas. 5:19 My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back,

NIV 2 Pet. 1:10 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, make every effort to confirm your calling and election. For if you do these things, you will never stumble,

NIV 1 Jn. 3:13 Do not be surprised, my brothers and sisters, if the world hates you.

NIV 1 Jn. 3:16 This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters.

NIV 3 Jn. 1:5 Dear friend, you are faithful in what you are doing for the brothers and sisters, even though they are strangers to you.

NIV Rev. 6:11 Then each of them was given a white robe, and they were told to wait a little longer, until the full number of their fellow servants, their brothers and sisters, were killed just as they had been.

NIV Rev. 12:10 Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say: "Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Messiah. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down.

NIV Rev. 19:10 At this I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "Don't do that! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers and sisters who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For it is the Spirit of prophecy who bears testimony to Jesus."
